- [1] It is suggested that each chaplain/priest-in-charge photocopy this blank form and keep copies for future use.
- [2] When completed, the application is to be sent to the archdeacon. The chaplain/priest-in-charge should keep a copy until the Permission has been received from the archdeacon.
- [3] The archdeacon will keep a copy of the application and Permission with his records, and will forward a copy of the Permission to the Diocesan Office for recording on the database.
- [4] The signed Permission should be kept in the church safe or other secure place.
- [5] Permission to distribute communion to the sick and housebound will be given only to those who have completed the safeguarding procedure. Chaplains/priests-in-charge wishing to make application for this permission should indicate by ticking the appropriate column for the individuals concerned.
- [5] This form of application and Permission is to be used only for baptised and confirmed members of the Church of England or a Church in full communion therewith. If a chaplain/priest-in-charge wishes to invite a baptised lay or ordained member of another Church to perform this or any other liturgical duty for which the Bishop's Permission is required, the form APPLICATION FOR THE BISHOP'S PERMISSION UNDER THE ECUMENICAL CANONS should be completed and sent to the Suffragan Bishop's Office.
