Many thanks to you and your congregation at Tous les Saints dans l'Herault for the very generous donation of €200 that just arrived in the LSR bank account. These have been trying times for us all in various ways but especially so for refugees who are forced to live without adequate housing, food supplies, warm clothing or other basic needs. With the help of generous people like yourselves LSR has been able to continue its humanitarian support programmes throughout.

We continue to provide regular food and supplies to numerous families in Beziers and Carcassonne and to help several families stay in housing and their children in school while the process of "regularizing" their presence in France continues. We are also currently providing very large quantities (lorry loads) of blankets, clothing, mattresses, etc. to the squats in Montpellier to see a growing number of homeless refugees through the winter.

As always we are a 100% volunteer association and operate with no fixed administrative expenses for rent, staff or other operating cost. Your role in helping us to continue on this basis is instrumental to our efforts to be of as much help as possible to as many refugees in need as possible.
